Antonelli wins in Japan and leads Formula 1

Suzuka, 30.03.2026 [ENA]

Kimi Antonelli wins the Japanese Grand Prix at Suzuka with a flawless performance and moves to the top of the Formula 1 World Championship. After more than twenty years, an Italian driver leads the standings again, reigniting excitement across global motorsport.

Suzuka [ENA] – This was not just another win, but a moment that carries real weight. Kimi Antonelli takes victory at the Japanese Grand Prix and climbs to the top of the Formula 1 World Championship, putting an Italian driver back in the lead after more than twenty years. On a track as demanding as Suzuka, he drove with calm and clarity, managing every phase of the race with confidence. The significance of this result goes beyond a single Grand Prix. Leading the World Championship again after such a long time restores visibility and credibility to Italian motorsport in Formula 1. In a highly competitive environment dominated by established champions and top teams, Antonelli has carved out his place with authority. His achievement is not only technical but also symbolic, representing a new generation capable of competing at the highest level without hesitation.

Now comes the hardest part: staying there. Leading the championship brings pressure, expectations, and a long season that leaves little room for mistakes. What Antonelli showed at Suzuka, though, was more than just speed — it was control, awareness, and the kind of maturity you don't often see so early. The title race is still wide open, but for the first time in years, Italy is watching it from the front, not from the sidelines — and that changes everything.
